**ORDER RETAINING JURISDICTION AND DIRECTING CASE TO COLLECTIONS
COURT FOR THE PURPOSE OF COLLECTING UNPAID RESTITUTION, COSTS,
INTEREST, PENALTIES, AND ATTORNEY FEES, IF APPLICABLE**

Pursuant to Fla. Stat. §985.201(4)(c), as amended, this Court retains jurisdiction over the Child and the Child's parent of legal guardian, all of whom have been ordered to pay restitution. Jurisdiction lasts until restitution is paid in full, plus interest, court costs, penalties, and attorney fees.

Pursuant to Fla. Stat. §985.05(5), as amended, this Court is transferring this case to "Collections Court" for the sole purpose of collecting the unpaid restitution and any and all associated costs, interest, penalties, and attorney fees, if applicable.
