ORDER OF REFERRAL TO MEDIATION

It appears to the Court that there is an issue as to the restitution amount in the above-styled case, and that it is in the best interest of the parties that they attempt to resolve the restitution issue with a mediator's assistance.

IT IS ORDERED as follows:

1) The Child and the Child's parent(s) and/or guardian(s) appear for Juvenile Delinquency Restitution Mediation which will be held on **Thursday, _____, 20_____ at 3:30 P.M. at the Osceola County Courthouse, 2 Courthouse Sq., First Floor, Dispute Resolution Office, Suite #1400, Kissimmee, FL 34741.** Failure to attend mediation will constitute a violation of this order and sanctions will be imposed by the Court.

2) That the Victim(s) of the Child's delinquency activity appear at the mediation hearing as set forth above. The Victim should bring to the hearing any documents - e.g., repair estimates, repair invoices, etc. which support the victim's restitution claim. Failure of the Victim to attend the hearing may result in the Court denying restitution.

3) The Mediator shall report to the Court only information as to whether the parties appeared for mediation and whether an agreement was reached.
